

REQUIREMENTS OF THE ABSTRACT

a. Formal requirements

Number of characters with spaces: minimum 1300 – maximum 2000 characters.

- *Title of the presentation:* The title of the presentation/poster must be written in capital letters. The title cannot contain the name of a company or institution. The purpose of the title is to inform the reader about the subject of the paper. A good title is short, brief, not too lengthy, refers to the topic of the paper and to the issue being examined. Indicate the topic chosen for elaboration precisely and clearly.

- *Authors:* data of the author(s) (name, specialization, class, study schedule, campus) must be aligned to the left, right under the title. One student can only be the first author in one presentation (co-author discretionarily).

- *Data of the supervisor(s)* (name /with scientific titles/, and lecturer/researches position) should be listed at the end of the abstract.

b. Content requirements (parts of the abstract)

- *Aim:* To define the topic of the dissertation in more detail than the title, to describe the antecedents of the Research, to justify the choice of the topic, and to determine the exact purpose of the research. It shall outline the theoretical and practical questions, tasks, and problems to be solved.

- Data and methods: Aim: To prove the methodological validity of the research, and to provide the information necessary for its repeatability. The description of the research type; target group; sample selection method; item number; a description of the inclusion and exclusion criteria; the designation of the place and time of testing; data collection methods; in the case of questionnaire use, the name of the standardized questionnaire; the name of the statistical test required for the type of research (e.g. chi-square; T-test; U-test; F-test); the name of the software used to run the statistical test (e.g. SPSS v14).

- *Results:* Aim: A textual presentation of the results of the research, with special emphasis on the new results of the student in the field of research. When presenting the results, the degree of significance (e.g. p < 0.005) and the confidence interval (e.g. [MT 1.7-5.8]) should be described in accordance with the applied statistical procedure. (It cannot contain abstract tables and figures.)

- *Conclusions:* Aim: Evaluation of the obtained results, presentation of their significance, especially in relation to the own new results. Description of the conclusions that can be drawn from the association of the own new results with international and domestic research results. The possibilities of continuing and expanding research.

- *Keywords:* Aim: The closer delimitation of the research area/topic. A minimum of 2 and a maximum of 5 keywords are required.

Note: Abstracts not prepared in accordance with the above requirements will be excluded from the competition by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty.
